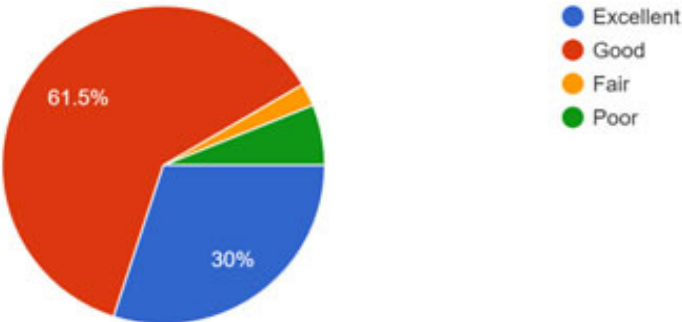


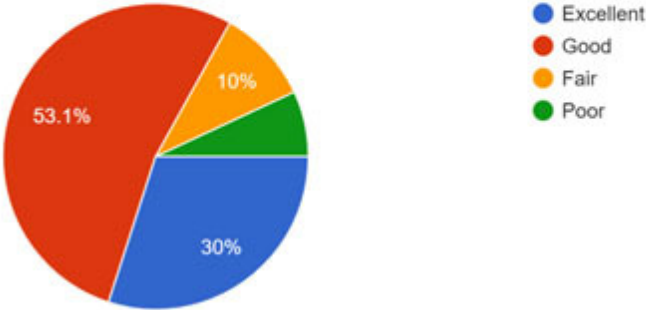
STUDENTS' FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM

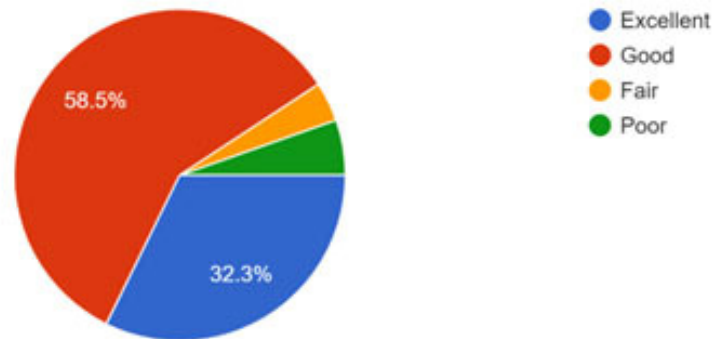
1. Curriculum and Syllabi of the courses:



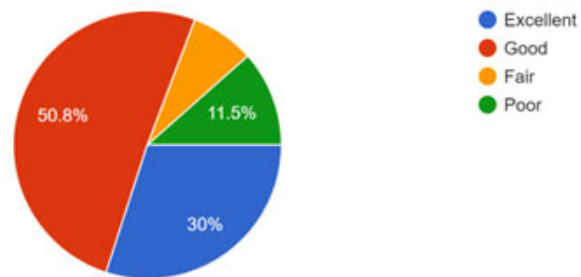
2. Extent of Syllabi covered in the class:



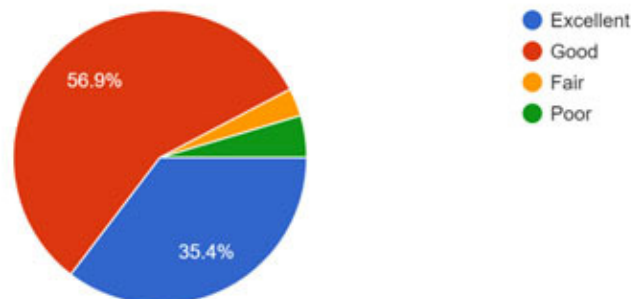

Summary of the analysis of student's feedback for the session 2022-23:

- ❖ Majority of students respond to the curriculum and syllabi as good.
- ❖ 5.4 percent of students are unhappy with the delay in the declaration of results.
- ❖ Sufficient numbers of students are happy with the availability of reading materials in the college library.
- ❖ 9.2 percent of students are unhappy with opportunities outside of the classroom. However maximum (56.9%) students are happy on this point.
- ❖ Majority (50.8%) students express their happiness on the use of ICT tools in the classroom.

Based on the findings, the administration, IQAC, and other relevant cells and committees have chalked out plans for improvement where necessary.

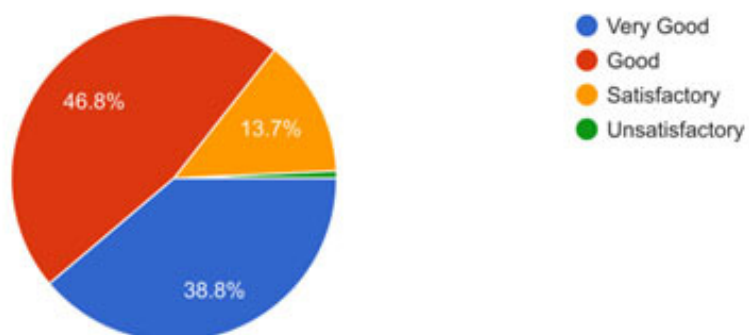

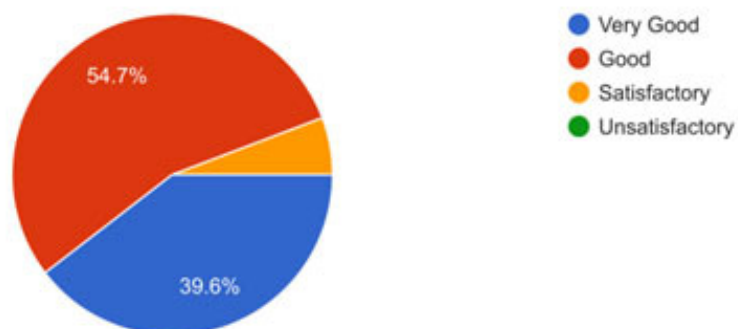

A Google Form was used to obtain student feedback on the faculty members of Mankachar College. A total of 520 students have responded. The collected data has been analyzed, and the results are shown below.

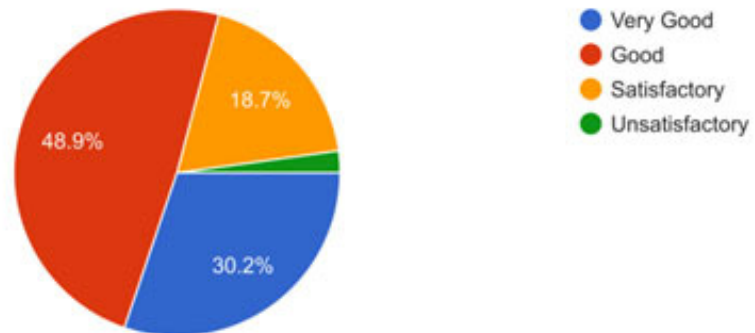

Summary of the analysis of student's feedback on teachers for the session 2022-23:

- ❖ Majority (46.8%) of students respond as good and 38.8 percent of students answer as very good on the teacher's punctuality in their activity.

- ❖ Majority of students respond that teachers are easily accessible and have good communication skills.

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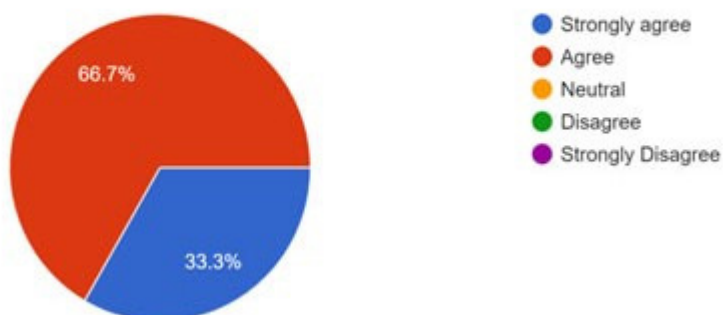
Teachers' Feedback on Curriculum




Summary of the analysis of teacher's feedback on Curriculum for the session 2022-23:

- ❖ Majority of the teachers are happy with the curriculum prescribed by the affiliated university and are of the view that objectives are well defined.
- ❖ All the teachers are aware about NEP 2020.
- ❖ Majority of teachers respond that examinations are conducted in time with proper coverage of all units in the syllabus.
- ❖ Nearly 16.7% of the teachers are of the opinion that prescribed books are not available in the college library.
- ❖ 50% of the teachers respond that ICT facilities are adequate and satisfactory.
- ❖ 66.7% of the teachers are using ICT for teaching.
- ❖ 91.7 % of the teachers are mentoring students.

Based on the findings, the management of the college has put emphasis for increasing the number of required books in the college library and ICT facilities. The IQAC always encourage the faculty members to use the available ICT facilities for teaching-learning process.


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
